

DOMESTIC ANIMAL CENSUS REGULARIZATION CAMPAIGN

From the Department of Animals of the City Council of San Fulgencio we want to launch a campaign to remind the owners of domestic animals the obligation to register them in the Municipal Census as marked by Law 4/1994, of July 8, of the Generalitat Valenciana, on Protection of Companion Animals. And Law 50/1999, of December 23, on the Legal Regime of the Possession of Potentially Dangerous Animals.

We understand that it is very important to have a municipal pet census updated to be able to locate the owners in case of loss or abandonment, promoting in this way the responsible ownership of domestic animals.

Census the animals in the municipality in which they reside is mandatory. However, we want to call for a responsible attitude and we will give a small gift to people who come to register.

The registration will be carried out in the registry of the San Fulgencio City Council from the urban area and the Registry Offices of the Urbanization City Council in La Marina, Monday to Friday from 9 a.m. to 1:30 p.m., by appointment.

As established by the Municipal Ordinance Regulating Possession and Protection of Companion Animals of San Fulgencio, published in the Official Gazette of the Province No. 165, dated 08/27/2015, the data that the owners of the Animals must offer are: the updated Passport with all vaccines stamped, the Certificate of Rivia, the identity document of the owner of the animal and proof of payment of the fee.

For the registration of Potentially Dangerous dogs, in addition to the data updated animals, owner data and the Rivia Certificate, must provide a Responsible Declaration of not being incapacitated to provide the necessary care to the animal, as well as not having been sanctioned by infractions in the matter of tendency of animals, nor deprived of capacity by cession administrative or judicial. Criminal record. Certificate of physical capacity and psychological aptitude for the tendency of animals of these characteristics, issued by a licensed psychologist within the three months prior to the date of application for administrative license and accreditation of having formalized civil liability insurance for damage to third parties that may be caused for their animals worth one hundred

twenty thousand two hundred two euros and forty-two cents (120.202,42 euros).

In the same way, the Department of Animals urges the population to update the census data when the animal changes address and to cancel it in case of death.
